1. Adjustments to the Agenda:

None

2. Approval of Minutes:

Motion made by Chris Hunter, seconded by Heather Bollman to accept the August 24, 2020 meeting minutes as presented. Motion carried 5 to 0.

3. Approval and signing of orders:

Motion made by Chris Hunter, seconded by Sarah Whittemore, to approve the orders drawn on the Treasurer for weeks 35 & 36 with the Treasurer to sign. Motion carried 5-0.

4. Bandstand Park Requests:

Abby Johnson, Children's Librarian at Cobleigh Public Library, has requested to extend two events they have been holding in the park, story time on Tuesday & Wednesday through the end of September and keep the Storywalks up until September 15th as well as hold a Family Fun Night on September 11, 2020 from 4 – 6 PM. Motion made by Susan Mills, seconded by Doug Conly, to approve all three events as requested. Motion carried 5-0.

5. Set Tax Rate:

Motion made by Chris Hunter, seconded by Doug Conly, set the tax rates as follows: The Village rate shall be set at \$.8324, the residential homestead will be \$1.3544, the nonresidential rate shall be \$1.6235, the town general shall be \$.4412, and the local agreement shall be \$.0038. The total homestead tax rate for village will be \$2.6317, while the total non-homestead tax rate will be \$2.9008. The motion carried 5-0.

6. Bids on Used Equipment:

Two trucks were put out to bid: 1997 & 1999 plow trucks no longer in use. One bid was received for each truck. The price we would receive if scrapped would be \$345 each. The bid received for the 1997 International 6-wheel dump truck is \$501 from Joe Dauphin. The bid received for the 1999 International Dump Truck is \$1,020 from Walt Neborsky. Motion made by Chris Hunter, seconded by Sarah Whittemore, to accept both bids as submitted. Motion carried 5-0.

7. Other:

- a. Annie McLean, Zoning Administrator, notified Justin of a minor subdivision on Heath Road that adjoins the village reservoir. The Twombly and Heath Family Trusts are subdividing the house and two acres for Kelly Heath Coons. The remaining 107 acres will stay in the family trust.
- b. Justin has spoken with Joe Dauphin regarding the missing tree in the village. Joe will be in contact with a landscaping business regarding the best tree to plant. If something can be done this fall, he will. If not, he will do it in the spring.

- c. Chris Hunter mentioned trash receptacles that are being left out past pick-up day which goes against the village ordinance. Justin will send a letter to the property owners reminding them of the ordinance.
