TO: ALL ORGANIZATIONS SEEKING A SPECIAL APPROPRIATION

The Town of Lyndon Selectboard approved the following policy at their 03/30/20 meeting:

It was approved by the voters at Town Meeting on March 5, 2019 to vote all Special Appropriations by Australian ballot. **Therefore, in order to be on the Australian ballot for Town Meeting 2021, organizations seeking a Special Appropriation from the Town of Lyndon, that did not submit a petition in 2020 or are requesting an amount higher than 2020, must submit a petition in accordance with 17 V.S.A. §2642 which requires “the petition language on each page on which signatures are collected and shall include the printed name, signature, and street address of each voter who signed the petition”. Petitions are due by 4:30 PM on Thursday, January 14, 2021. If you submitted a petition in 2020 and are not changing the requested amount, you do not need to submit a petition in 2021.**

The Selectboard wanted to give advance notice so that all organizations would have ample time to get the petitions filled. Such petition must be signed by at least five percent of the voters of the town and filed with the Town Clerk not less than 47 days before the day of the annual meeting. The petition should be in substantially the following form:

Petition of Legal Voters of the Town of Lyndon

We, the undersigned legal voters of the Town of Lyndon, hereby petition the Selectboard to add the following article to the warning for the annual town meeting to be held on Tuesday, March 3, 2021:

Shall the Town appropriate \$[insert amount of request] to [insert name of social service agency], for [insert brief description of the purpose of the proposed appropriation] in accordance with 24 V.S.A. § 2691?

Pursuant to 17 V.S.A. § 2642(a)(3)(C), a petition must contain the petition language on every page on which signatures are collected and must contain the printed name, signature, and street address of each voter who signs the petition. Enclosed is a blank sample form.

The following requirements also apply to all organizations each year:

1. You must send a written request to the Selectboard **no later than December 31, 2020**. Requests may be mailed to the address listed above. Email is acceptable.
2. You must submit a **one-page** report about your organization suitable for publication in the Town Report **no later than December 31, 2020**.
3. It is strongly advised to have a representative of the organization attend the informational meeting prior to Town Meeting. The date is to be determined.

The 2021 Annual Town Meeting date is Tuesday, March 3, 2021
