1. Joint Garage:

Mark Stewart of Mark G. Stewart, Architect (MGSA) explained that the purpose of this meeting was to get all parties involved to discuss the wants and needs for the Joint Garage project. He will also be visiting both the Town & Village Highway garages to obtain a better understanding of the equipment they both have.
