1. Ron Aiken called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.
2. Justin Smith requested that two items be added to the agenda: Stars & Stripes for a Bandstand Park Request and the approval of the annual Highway Financial Plan for VTrans.
3. Minutes: Sue Mills made a motion to approve the minutes from February 27, 2017. Doug Conly seconded and the motion carried 4-0-1 with Chris Hunter abstaining.
4. Bandstand Park Requests:
 - a. Chris Hunter made a motion to approve H.O.P.E.'s request to hold their annual Color Run event in Bandstand Park on Saturday, April 29th, 2017 from 8AM-2PM. Justin Smith noted that Jack Harris has requested the same conditions as last year the color will be throw from private properties not from public sidewalks where those not intending to participate could be colored. He also requested that Maple Street be closed as a safety precaution. Justin Smith said he would also inform H.O.P.E. that the park needed to be picked up prior to leaving the site. It was noted in the request that music will begin at 9:00 AM. Heather Bollman seconded with the conditions mentioned, and the motion carried 5-0.
 - b. Ron Aiken made a motion to approve the Lyndonville Chamber of Commerce's request to hold their annual Stars & Stripes event in Bandstand Park on Saturday July 15th, 2017 the event will run all day with some tents likely to set up on Friday afternoon. Justin Smith noted that last year there were issues with several business owners not being happy that customers were unable to enter the Village due to the parade route which requires the North end of Main Street to be re-routed onto Stevens Loop. There was a discussion last year that a condition should be added that required the Chamber to visit all businesses in the Village to make them aware of the date of Stars & Stripes and any road closings that will occur. Doug Conly seconded, with the condition that the chamber inform businesses which will be affected by road closings as a result of the Stars & Stripes event and the motion carried 5-0.
5. Highway Financial Plan: Sue Mills made a motion to approve and sign the annual Highway Financial Plan for the Village required by VTrans. Chris Hunter seconded and the motion carried 5-0.
6. Having no other business the meeting was turned over to LED at 6:12 PM.
