1. Ron Aiken called the meeting to order at 6:00 PM.
2. Minutes: Chris Hunter made a motion to approve the minutes from May 22nd, 2017 with one change, which was to remove Amy Nixon from the attendees list. Heather Bollman seconded, and the motion carried 5-0.
3. Orders: The Board signed the orders for weeks 22-23.
4. Reclamation Bid for Park Avenue: Heather Bollman made a motion to accept the Reclaim bid from Pike Industries, which was the low bidder at \$.89/sq. yd. Chris Hunter seconded, and the motion carried 5-0.
5. Paving Bid for the Park Avenue: Susan Mills made a motion to accept the paving bid from J. Hutchins, Inc., which was the low bidder at \$66.00/ton. Doug Conly seconded, and the motion carried 5-0
6. Tax Anticipation Note Interest Rate: Heather Bollman made a motion to accept the interest rate bid from the Union Bank, which was the low bidder with an interest rate of .99%. Susan Mills seconded, and the motion carried 5-0.
7. Revenue Anticipation Note Interest Rate: Susan Mills made a motion to accept the interest rate bid from the Union Bank, which was the low bidder with an interest rate of .99%. Ron Aiken seconded, and the motion carried 5-0.
8. Other:
  - a. The Trustees stated that the Park looks beautiful with all the work that has been done.
  - b. Steve Gray stated that H.O.P.E. will be holding its coin drop July 22, 2017 with a rain date of July 29<sup>th</sup>, 2017. The Trustees reminded Mr. Gray that a notification is required in the road on Broad Street as you approach the intersection with Depot Street where the actual coin drop is located.
